

Academic Eligibility

5280.R

Students are responsible for knowing their academic status and maintain passing grades. Should a student need academic support, several opportunities for improving grades are available, such as peer tutoring, remediation period and other forms of extra help upon student request through their teachers and guidance.

Academic Probation

Grades will be reviewed every 3 weeks, 5 weeks and 8 weeks and 10 weeks. At the 3 week review, all students failing one or more classes will receive a warning letter. At the 5 week review, student's will be placed at Level One or a Level Two, if their grade(s) have not improved to passing. The next review of grades will be eight weeks and then at ten weeks. The process repeats itself each quarter throughout the school year. The process begins the first time a student is on the warning list.

Level One

Student is failing one grade

Student may practice

Student can participate in games/school functions

Student must attend 3-10th period classes with teacher of failing class (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) each week until removed from the ineligibility list.

Student may be eligible for removal from list with teacher signature at any time

Level Two

Student is failing two or more classes

Student may practice

Student must attend 3-10th period classes with teacher of failing class (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) each week until removed from the ineligibility list.

Student may not participate on games or school functions for one week

Student can be reinstated to participate in games and school functions after one week with a teacher signature and passing grades

Level Two

Students who are on Level Two twice for an activity are suspended for four weeks.

All participants who are academically ineligible at the end of June will begin the following school year on Level One probation.
